While looking forward to welcome you directly here in Vilnius, we would like to introduce you to Vilnius Jesuit High School and its campsite – the sites the tournament will take place at – to make a small prelude to your visit.

Here are a few pictures of Vilnius Jesuit High School ->

It is situated in the most picturesque site of Vilnius, namely in the Old Town that according to UNESCO resolution is included in the List of World Cultural Heritage.



The history of Vilnius Jesuit High School goes back to 1570 when Colegium Vilnense Societati Jesu has been established.

In September 1995 it reopened its doors for the schoolchildren of the independent Lithuania.

There are 638 students of 10- 19 years old age currently studying at Vilnius Jesuit High School.

Basically there are two sites in Lithuania in which JeSET 2010 will take place. Basketball, volleyball, table tennis and chess games will be played in the town Vilnius - in the premises, surroundings and neighbourhoods of Vilnius Jesuit High School.

During the championship, the majority (but not all) of the participants playing basketball, volleyball, table tennis and chess will be accommodated in Vilnius Jesuit High School students' homes or Filaretai hostel located in Vilnius old town.

The construction of the sports hall had been started from zero in 2004 and was completely finished a few years ago ->



The championship will also take place in a neighbouring Vytautas Magnus High School sports hall.

In 2009, the area of the sports field was renovated: new chamfers were mounted, the cover

of football field and basketball playground were changed, safety fences were built, electricity and lighting were installed.



These are pictures of Vilnius Jesuit High School campsite that is 25 km from Vilnius ->

The cross country, football and beach volleyball matches will take place here.



At the moment, the beach volleyball court and football field are under construction to be prepared for the tournament.

There is a main building, two cottages and a lake ;) on the campsite.



There will be tournament buses running from the campsite to Vilnius and back during the

tournament to establish a connection between the two points of the championship and to let the participants of different sports observe or take part in other games.

The majority of football and beach volleyball players will be accommodated in the campsite premises during JeSET.



The rooms here are of different sizes: starting with single rooms, finishing with ten-bed rooms and joined rooms.



During the tournament, most of the cultural, social and spiritual evening events for all participants will take place in Vilnius Jesuit High School and Vilnius town.



There will also be one evening event for everybody organised in the campsite.



All in all, we will be around 250 participants of JeSET 2010 challenging each other in fair play and starting new friendships with people from different European countries and Jesuit schools.
